NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE (NOC) FROM MINISTRY OF EDUCATION
(FOR PHD DOCTORS, MS PROGRAM AND ETC)

These are the requirements for obtaining No Objection Certificate from the Ministry of Education, Government of Pakistan, Islamabad.

1. An Undertaking from you stating that you would/would not return to Pakistan after completing of your residency program. (This may be notarized)
2. Residency Agreement/offer of a Job.
3. Passport copies. 1-4 & last 2 pages & J-1 visa page with copy of IAP-66/I-20 from the date you entered in USA.
4. An attested copy of Pakistani NICOP (I.D. Card)
5. A letter indicating the reason for NOC.
6. A letter indicating if NOC was issued previously, if yes sends a copy of it. If not indicate.
7. Please state if you are/were Government employee and or availed any Government's scholarship.
8. NOC from the organization who signed your IAP-66/I-20 on arrival to USA.
9. Copies of you Bachelor, MS, PH D degree.
10. Fee for NOC is US \$ 5.00 (Money order in the name of the Embassy of Pakistan, Washington D.C.)
11. (PLEASE NOTE THAT SEND 3 SETS OF ALL DOCUMENTS)
